

Mental Health Center Of Excellence	All of the MH CoEs have a singular mission: to improve the health and well being of veterans through world class, cutting-edge science, education and clinical care.
National Center For PTSD	Center of Excellence for research and education on the prevention, understanding, and treatment of PTSD. Provide no direct clinical care, purpose is to improve the well-being and understanding of American Veterans. Conduct cutting edge research and apply resultant findings to: 'Advance the Science and Promote Understanding of Traumatic Stress.' There are several divisions across the country
Epilepsy Center of Excellence	Epilepsy CoEs have active programs to evaluate medically intractable patients with video EEG monitoring at VA and offer AED treatment, surgical evaluation, vagus nerve stimulator, implantation and surgical resection
Multiple Sclerosis Center of Excellence	The Centers of Excellence are dedicated to further the understanding of the disease, its impact on Veterans, and effective treatments to help manage MS symptoms. By partnering with Veterans, caregivers, and health care providers the Centers hope to minimize disease impairment and increase the quality of life for Veterans with MS.
Parkinson's Disease Research Education and Clinical Centers (PADRECC)	Designated VA Centers of Excellence - Receive referrals across the VA Healthcare System Each serve a large geographic region. PADRECCs are staffed by internationally known movement disorder specialists, neurosurgeons, psychiatrists, psychologists, nurses, researchers, educators, social workers, and other PD experts. PADRECCs assist veterans in effectively managing PD and other movement disorders by way of VA pharmacy benefits, physical, occupational, and speech therapies, medical equipment, surgical services, and other valuable resources.
Parkinsons Diseases Consortium Center	PD and movement disorder specialty care to veterans who cannot travel to a PADRECC. These Centers are staffed by movement disorder specialists or clinicians with vast experience and/or interest in the field of movement disorders. Consortium Centers work collaboratively with the PADRECCs to ensure the highest level of care for all veterans.
War Related Illness and Injury Study Center (WRIISC)	The War Related Illness and Injury Study Center (WRIISC) is a National VA Post-Deployment Health Resource. The WRIISCs focus on the post deployment health concerns of Veterans and their unique health care needs. The WRIISCs develop and provide post-deployment health expertise to Veterans and their health care providers through clinical programs, research, education, and risk communication.






